Common Award System (CAS)

- Single coherent way of developing awards
- Single credit accumulation and transfer system
- Common Format
- Widens participation
- New pathways



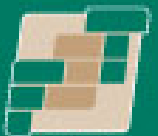

Common format of all CAS awards

Presented in award specifications

- Major award – Certificate Specification
- Special Purpose award – Specific Purpose Specification
- Supplemental Award – Supplemental Specification
- Minor award – Component specification

CAS – for providers

- Advantages
 - More awards available - opportunity
 - Open access
 - Programme validation
- Need to get used to
 - Looking at certificate specs and component specs
 - Checking for validation requirements
 - Checking for supporting documentation requirements
 - Submitting programme(s) for validation

CAS – for learners

- Advantages

- Wider range of awards they can access
- Accumulate minors – building blocks
- Major/sp p/supp will be graded (Level 4-6)
- Progression opportunities e.g. scoring system for CAO clarified

- Need to get used to

- Credit system
- Looking at certificate specs and component specs
- Checking if provider has validated programme

Validation only applies to programmes leading to Common Awards

Validation applications can **only** be made by registered **providers**

Validation applies even if you already offer a programme leading to an existing award when it is migrated

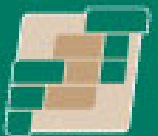

- Learners can achieve certification

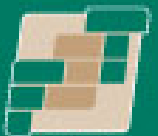

Programmes

- The learning package designed, developed and delivered by the provider
- Describes how the award standard will be reached
- Provides insight into the learning experiences on offer



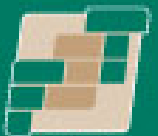

Programme v award

- Award standard states what the learner will be able to know and/or do on achievement of the award i.e. it is the knowledge, skill and competence associated with the award
- Programme is about the learning experience the learner will participate in, in order to gain that knowledge, skill and competence

In very simple terms the award is the **destination** while the programme is the **journey**.

Programme Descriptor Concept

- Houses all information for a programme in a single document
- Covers all information required for validation application
- Owned and maintained by provider
- Provider can add to it

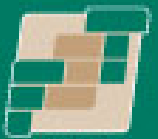

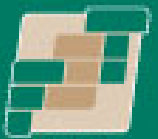

Validate a Joint Programme

- Step 1 – Providers A, B and C group together to develop a programme jointly
- Step 2 – Providers agree lead provider to evaluate, approve and submit programme to FETAC
- Step 3 – Lead provider sends programme to FETAC with list and consent of providers who are part of the joint application
- Step 4 – FETAC evaluate and **validate** programme for all providers listed

Shared Programme Validation

- Step 1 – Programme developed by Provider A
- Step 2 – Provider A sends programme validation application to FETAC with full programme descriptor and list of providers who can share (including Provider B)
- Step 3 - Programme evaluated and **validated for Provider A only** and **approved for sharing** with other providers (list) by FETAC

Shared Programmes Validation cont.

- Step 4 – FETAC develops a ‘Use a Shared Programme Form’
- Step 5 – Provider B applies to FETAC for the ‘Use a Shared Programme Form’ – FETAC gives them the form and programme descriptor
- Step 6 – Provider B completes the ‘Use a Shared Programme Form and returns to FETAC
- Step 7 – Provider B validated to use the programme (ownership transfers to provider B)

Criteria

Consistency: Award Programme QA

Coherence: Objectives Learner Profile Structure
Delivery Assessment

Capacity: Awareness Ability Facilities

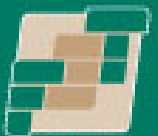
Compliance: Awards QA Duration ATP Assessment

The programme's potential to **enable** the learner to meet the standards of knowledge, skill and competence for the awards based on the specified learner profile and the standards for the award.

Managing the changeover

Providers need to allow time for:

- Programme development
- Programme validation
- Completion of existing programmes

Programme Validation

Approx. 12 weeks

Delays caused by:

- Incomplete application forms
- Incorrect or inappropriate information

Delays can be avoided if the programme developer is familiar with the **Guidelines** and ensures that the **Programme Descriptor** is fully completed with the correct information
