



STANDING ORDERS - ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

1. Only members and representatives of members are entitled to speak or vote.
2. The proposer of a resolution or an amendment may not speak for more than three minutes.
3. A member or representative of a member may not speak more than once to a resolution or amendment and may not exceed two minutes.
4. A direct negative to a resolution may not be moved.
5. The proposer of a resolution or amendment which has been the subject of a debate shall be granted two minutes to reply, whereupon the vote must be taken subject, however to the provisions of Standing Order No 9.
6. The chairperson may, whenever he/she considers a matter has been adequately discussed, call on the proposer to reply when the provisions of Standing Order No 5 will obtain.
7. A member or representative of a member may, with the consent of the chairperson, move "that the question be now put", and if carried, the provisions of Standing Order No 5 will obtain.
8. A matter not on the agenda may be raised only with the consent of two - thirds at least of those present and entitled to vote.
9. A member or representative of a member may, with the consent of the chairperson, raise a Point of Order, Point of Procedure or Point of Information on a relevant matter. If the request is acceded to, the speaker concerned may not speak for more than two minutes whereupon the chairperson will rule thereon.
