Erasmus+ KA1 Course: AONTAS – 5 Day Residential Programme

Linking to the broader lifelong learning advocacy movement of the International Council of Adult Learning (ICAE) International Academy of Lifelong Learning Advocacy, and the European Association for the Education of Adults (EAEA) Younger Staff Training, the first AONTAS Lifelong Learning Advocacy Summer School will be offered in partnership with Maynooth University from 18th – 22nd June 2018, Kildare, Ireland.



AONTAS as the national adult learning organisation in Ireland, with a track record of advocacy, European engagement and expertise, is striving to support the next generation of lifelong learning advocates in order to make educational equality a reality for all adults across Europe.

This 5 day residential programme will draw on the expertise of academics, practitioners and leaders in the field of adult learning advocacy. Open to emerging advocates from across Europe, this ERASMUS+ Key Action 1 programme will be hosted by the highly regarded Department of Adult and Community Education in Maynooth University, Kildare, Ireland.

The programme will have core elements of:

- Expertise: Expert inputs from AONTAS, Maynooth University and other leaders in the lifelong learning field
- Participation: Interactive and innovative workshops
- Networking: With other adult learning practitioners

Objectives:

- To build a movement of lifelong learning advocates in Ireland and across Europe
- To learn about adult and community education in an Irish context
- To increase advocacy capacity including how to meaningfully engage with learners
- To learn about best practice examples in advocacy and promotional activities
- Expand networking opportunities for ERASMUS+ projects

Location:

Maynooth University, Co Kildare, Ireland will be the venue for both the programme and accommodation, which will facilitate maximum engagement and networking of participants. Site visits to other locations including Dublin will be offered.

Official registration opens on the 30th March 2018. Applicants will be required to apply with a letter of motivation, CV and an indication if you are covered by the ERASMUS+ KA1 programme or other funding before 30th April 2018. **Details on official registration to follow.**

The course is limited to 20 participants, with a maximum of 5 places for participants from Ireland. A registration fee of €100 will apply. The full cost of the training is €450 EUR (including the registration fee) covering the cost of programme refreshments and lunches. AONTAS has a number of scholarships available for applicants who are not covered by the ERASMUS+ mobility programme.
